CHANGED FOREVER: Citizens running scared with fear of more attacks.

Citizens left in turmoil.

Citizens of Exeter have been left in turmoil after the raids. Many of the citizens left the city and sheltered in the nearby villages and even took up residences in hedgerows and fields.

Bombing attacks on the outskirts of Exeter have been taking place over the last 3 days. The first attack, bombs fell west of the river in St Thomas and Marsh Barton resulting in four Fatalities. The second raid came at 12.06am on Saturday 25th April, the alarm was sounded and parachute flares were dropped to guide bombers to their targets. Large numbers of 1kg incendiary bombs intercepted with high explosives were dropped over Pennsylvania and other scattered parts of the city. This

time the casualties were greater with 73 dead and 20 seriously injured.

Sunday night there was a smaller raid and another 3 dead. It is thought that these attacks have taken place because Hitler is enraged by the resent RAF's bombing attack on the ancient German cathedral city of Lubeck.
