

A large part of the City Centre and the St Sidwells area were left in ruins this day. The Blitz has really came in two parts firstly the three attacks in April when residential areas outside the City Centre were hit. When the people of Exeter went bed on Saturday night 3rd May they did not know that a few hours later they would be woken by the wail of sirens. Within minutes a terrible raid had

begun. Hundreds of

men and women will forever have vivid memories of the bombing and the damage that has been caused.

For those people huddled and wide awake in their shelters it was a night of fear. There was a tremendous noise It wasn't just the bombs. They were dive bombing and you have all the screaming of the planes coming down and going up the bomb was and exploding and the machine gun fire.
